Scope and Content:

This collection contains audio recordings, notes and transcriptions of ethnographic interviews with residents of primarily Newfoundland and Labrador conducted by undergraduate students, as well as photographs, drawings, pamphlets and other materials, and some video recordings. Students collected these materials under the direction and supervision of faculty members in Folklore, Sociology, and Anthropology as part of their coursework.

The collection is arranged into series for each Instructor in the Social/Cultural Studies program who was supervising the field work, subdivided by the course and by the semester: the Dr. John Ashton series, the Dr. Colin Quigley series, the Dr. Elke Dettmer series, the Dr. Doreen Klassen series, the Dr. James Moreira series, the Dr. Contessa Jeanette Small series, the Dr. Ivan Emke series, and the Dr. John Bodner series, as well as a miscellaneous series where the instructor, course and/or date is unknown.

History:

The collection was initially created and maintained by Dr. John Ashton. Referred to as the "Folklore Archives and Resource Centre", it was housed in the original Arts and Science Building. Instructors in the Social/Cultural Studies program also regularly contributed material. Dr. Ashton died in 2008. From 2008 to 2012, Dr. Doreen Klassen, voluntarily maintained the collection, until, in 2012, it was transferred to the Archives in the newly constructed Arts & Science Extension. The Folklore Archives and Resource Centre assigned item level accession numbers based on the system used in the Memorial University of Newfoundland Folklore and Language Archive in St. John's.

Biographies:

Dr. John Ashton (1952-2008). Born in England, Dr. Ashton came to Canada to study at Memorial University in 1975, receiving his PhD in Folklore. He studied folksong, in particular, lumber camp songs. An internationally recognized, prize-winning scholar in his field, he worked at what was then called Sir Wilfred Grenfell College for 26 years as an Associate Professor and, from 2004 to 2008, was Principal of the College.

Dr. Colin Quigley taught in the Folklore Department of Memorial University, and briefly taught at Sir Wilfred Grenfell College in the 1980s. He received his MA from Memorial University and his PhD from the University of California. Dr. Quigley has published two books, *Close to the Floor: Folk Dance in Newfoundland* (1985), and *Music From the Heart* (1995) about French Newfoundland fiddle music.

Dr. Elke Dettmer is from Germany and first came to St. John's in 1982 to complete her PhD in Folklore at Memorial. She briefly taught at Sir Wilfred Grenfell College in the 1980s. In 1994, she co-founded the East Coast Trail Association to develop and maintain a network of hiking paths along the eastern edge of the Avalon Peninsula and was awarded the Governor General's Sovereign's Medal for Volunteers in 2019 for her efforts. Dr. Dettmer published her translation of Hermann Bausinger's *Folk Culture in a World of Technology* in 1990, and *Newfoundland and Labrador: Insider's Perspectives* (2001).

Dr. Doreen Helen Klassen (b.1944). Anthropologist, Dr. Klassen, began teaching at Sir Wilfred Grenfell College in 1999 and retired in 2019. She received an MA from the University of Manitoba and PhD from Indiana University. Her research has taken her to Zimbabwe, Botswana, Mexico and Belize, where she has studied women's autobiographical and imaginative storytelling.

Dr. James Moreira. An Anthropologist with MA and PhD from Memorial University, he studies folksongs, ballads and literature. A former Director of the Main Folklife Centre, Dr. Moreira has been an Associate Professor at the University of Maine at Machias since 2007. His publications include *Tempered by Rum: Rum in the History of the Maritime Provinces* (Pottersfield, 1988) and *The Glenbuchat Ballads* (UP Mississippi, 2007).

Dr. Contessa Jeanette Small, was a folklore undergraduate student at Sir Wilfred Grenfell College and returned to the college as an Instructor. She received her PhD in Folklore from Memorial University and studies children's folklore and popular culture. Her thesis (2015) was *Co-Creating Harry Potter: Children's Fan-Play, Folklore and Participatory Culture*.

Dr. Ivan Emke taught sociology and anthropology at Sir Wilfred Grenfell College from 1993 until his retirement in 2018. He did his BA (1984) at Ohio State, MA (1985) at the University of Windsor, and PhD (1991) at Carleton University. His research interests include, rural development; the funeral services industry; and intercultural competence, recognition and celebration of diversity, and integration of newcomers with current residents in rural regions. A champion of community radio, he has hosted numerous programs on stations like Bay of Islands Radio and has a podcast "Fit to Eat: The Newfoundland Farm and Food Show."

Dr. John Bodner (b. 1969) holds an MA and PHD in Folklore from Memorial University and began teaching in the Social-Cultural Studies program in 2008. His teaching and research interests include popular culture, marginalized communities, nontraditional labouring, and contemporary conspiracy theories. His work on Covid-19 conspiracy theories and practices and can be read in the co-authored book, *Covid-19 Conspiracy Theories QAnon, 5G, the New World Order and Other Viral Ideas* (2021). He established the John Ashton Folklore Award with Sheila Ashton and friends of the program in honour of Dr. Ashton, and is Chair of the Grenfell Campus Archives Board.
