Scope and Content:

Personal copy of Dr. Janzen's Expert Report Supporting Documents submitted as evidence in the case of *Queen v. Drew et al. 2003*. The case was a land dispute between the government and Mi'kmaq in the Bay du Nord Wilderness Reserve in Bay d'Espoir on the south coast of Newfoundland. It contains copies of primary source material about European exploration in southern Newfoundland in the 18th century.

Biography: Dr. Janzen, Professor Emeritus of History at Memorial University's Grenfell Campus, has researched and published about the trade, society and defense of 18th century Newfoundland. He is a Fellow of the Royal Historical Society and member of several organizations, including the International Maritime Economic History Association, the Canadian Nautical Research Society, and the Newfoundland Historical Society. He is the 2024 recipient of the Newfoundland and Labrador Historical Society Heritage Fellowship Award for contributing significantly to the preservation and/or dissemination of the written record of the history of Newfoundland and Labrador.
